Are You Eligible to Vote on November 8?

According to the Board of Elections, since the election of 2012, 2,559 people have been removed from the voting rolls in Adams County! In general, if an individual has not voted in four years, they are no longer registered.

Please verify you are on the rolls and are eligible to vote in November by calling the Board of Elections at 937-544-2633 or drop by 215 North Cross Street. If you are no longer on the rolls, you need to complete a Voter Registration form and deliver it to the Board of Elections by 4 pm on Tuesday October 11th.

We encourage you to check with family and friends to help them get registered.

Trump was born into wealth and privilege. He has little in common with his followers. He presents himself as a hardworking genius in the business world and claims making “deals” is his personal “sacrifice” in life. The goal of deal-making is to get what he wants. His business judgement has led to bankruptcies six times. He has been involved in at least 3,500 lawsuits in state and federal courts

Trump has used foreign laborers and manufacturers to produce goods sold for profit in the USA. He has driven many trade workers, such as plumbers, painters and electricians, into financial loss by refusing to pay them. 
